## Purpose For My Life



Did you know that God created you for a purpose? That's right, when you were born God knew exactly what He wanted for your life. You were created in God's image. He said that way back in the very first book of the Bible, in a book called Genesis. The Bible also says in Ephesians 2:10 that, "God has made us what we are. In Christ Jesus, God made us to do good works, which God planned in advance for us to live our lives doing."

You see, our life has a purpose. But I must tell you that you do have a choice. We were not created as robots to go around and do God's purpose for our lives. It says in Luke 7:30 that, "The Pharisees and experts on the law refused to accept God's plan for themselves." If we choose not to follow God's purposes for our life then we are on our own just like those Pharisees and experts on the law. The Pharisees were very religious people but they didn't have the right attitude. They decided for themselves that they would carry out their own purpose for their lives and do you know what? It didn't work, not even close. I guess the best way to describe what God wants for us is to just say it. Are you ready? Because here it comes.



There are four bases for us to grow spiritually. It's up to us whether or not we follow through. Here they are. God wants us to Know Christ, Grow in Christ, Serve Christ and Share Christ with those around us who don't know Him. If you can, picture a baseball diamond where there is first base, second base, third base and home plate. Well, think of these four bases as bases of growth for your life. It's kind of like running the bases of maturity. When you hit the ball you don't run to second, do you? Of course not, that would be out of order. You run to first base first, and second base second, and so on. In your mind picture first base as Knowing Christ. Picture second base as Growing in Christ. Picture third base as Serving Christ, and finally picture home plate as Sharing Christ. Now with this lesson on purpose, you have hit the ball. Now start running toward first base by Knowing Christ.

### Expect to share Christ with others


Acts 1:8 talks about being a witness to other people. What does it mean to be a witness for Christ?

## The Bible

Did you know the word Bible really means "book"? That's right! In fact the Bible contains 66 smaller books that all have titles. The Bible has been divided into two sections, the first part is called the Old Testament. The Old Testament is made up of 39 books. The New Testament contains 27 books. The first book in the Bible is called Genesis, and the last book of the Bible is called Revelation. Most of the books in the Bible were written by different people at different times in history. It's also interesting to know that the Bible contains no mistakes.



That's right, not even one mistake! The verses we read in 2 Timothy chapter 3 talk about the Bible being "God-breathed." That means God spoke through ordinary men to write an extraordinary book! The Bible is also the main way God communicates to us, so don't forget to read your Bible every day.
