First Step to Know Christ

Salvation



Read the story about a man named Nicodemus in John 3:1-7 and then read the following paragraph!

Jesus told us that we must be "born again" in order to get to heaven. Well, we all know that we have been born once, since we are all here! What Jesus meant is that we must be born again into His family. We must become children of God. How do we become "Born Again"? We get born again by asking Jesus to come and live in our hearts. We ask Jesus to come and live in our hearts by doing and remembering four things:

#1

The first thing we need to do is understand that God loves us! In fact, it says in John 3:16 that God loved us so much that He sent His only son to die for us.

#2

The second thing we need to do is understand that we all sin. Sin means that we are not doing what God wants us to do. In Romans 3:23 the Bible says that we all sin and sin is the only thing that can keep us out of heaven.

The third thing for us to understand is that even though we sin, God has provided a way to get to heaven through His son Jesus. The Bible says in John 14:6 that the only way to get to heaven is through Jesus. We just need to ask Him to come and be that "Way" for us. "How do you do that?" you ask. Check out the fourth and final step.

#4

The fourth thing we need to do is ask Jesus into our hearts by praying and inviting Him to come and live inside of us. Your prayer could go something like this: "Dear Jesus, I understand that I don't always do the things that you want me to do. I need your help and I want you to be my Savior. Thank you for dying on the cross for all those sins I commit. Amen."
