Quiet Time



Let's take a quick minute and talk about attention. You know, the kind of attention adults like to talk about. In fact, maybe you have heard your mom or dad or even a teacher at school tell you to "pay attention," or they may ask you for your "undivided attention." That means they really want you to listen or look and see what is going on. They want you to be focused. But let's face it, sometimes these things called interruptions get in our way of paying attention.

For example, you have just gotten a brand new video game. You are all set to try it out for the first time. You have been waiting all day anticipating the very moment when you could dart out of school and get home to play the brand new game. You start the game and watch as all the beginning graphics play. Just when all the cool graphics stop and you are ready to start playing, your best friend knocks at the door. Oh no! A huge interruption, the game no longer has your undivided attention. So you run and answer the door, say you can't come outside right now and you sit back down to start the game. All of a sudden the phone rings...and it's for you! Ahhhh, another interruption. You talk on the phone with your friend for a quick second, then back to the game.



Well, I think you get the idea about interruptions and what it means to pay attention. We like to pay attention to our video games and we certainly need to pay attention to our parents and teachers. But there is one other person we almost always forget to pay attention to, and that person is Jesus. One of the ways we can take time and pay attention to Jesus is through a "Quiet Time." A Quiet Time is exactly that, a time to be quiet and read a couple of verses in your Bible and pray a simple prayer to God.

Take about 10 minutes right before you go to bed at night and read your Bible and say a short prayer. Try not to have any interruptions and pay attention, for a few minutes to God.
