Step Up to Serve Christ

Serving Others



Read Matthew 25:31-46.

The above verses are known as a "parable." Many times Jesus would tell stories to make a point, those stories were called parables. A parable is an earthly story with a heavenly meaning. This particular parable is called "The Parable of the Sheep and the Goats." In this story Jesus reminds us not only "why" we serve but "who" we serve.

Whenever we see someone in need we should do the best we can to serve them. We are reminded in this story that when we help those in need we are really serving God. Ephesians 6:7 tells us to, "Do your work with enthusiasm. Work as if you were serving the Lord, not as if you were serving only men and women."

Jesus even led us by example. He didn't come to this earth to be served but to serve others. We need to follow that example. Can you think for a minute about what ministry you are serving in?

Maybe you are serving the children's ministry by being a helper in a classroom. Maybe you are serving with your parents in a ministry by helping keep the church campus clean. Maybe you are serving as a greeter at a service. Or maybe, just maybe, you can't think of a ministry you are serving in.

I'm not talking about a one-time type of a ministry. You know, you stay after on Sunday to clean up the classroom because your leader asked you to. No, I'm talking about a regular ministry of service.



Service, you can say, is something you participate in on a weekly basis or every few days. For example, every Sunday you help with the puppet ministry at 11:00. You are on time, have the right attitude and want to serve.

If you think that you are not serving in a ministry, you are probably right and that's great! At least you realize it! The question now is, "what are you going to do about it?" We are going to spend the next few minutes exploring why we need to serve and how we can serve. As you work through this lesson, begin to think how you can best be used by God to serve others.
